The One Child, One Computer Varsity College One2One program grants each student with the opportunity to receive a computing device for their individual use. Varsity College is able to purchase high performance commercial-grade computers that are designed to survive the rigours of school environments while remaining well below the retail cost of the same or similar devices.

student conditions

I also understand that...

- 1** I am responsible for the regular backup of all data using a personal SD card, USB flash drive, external hard drive or cloud-based storage platform.
- 2** If the computer comes to the One2One Office for any repairs, it may be **reimaged** and **all data** and **programs** will be **lost**.
- 3** Technicians in the One2One Office will **not** retrieve any files from the hard drive on the computer.
- 4** Subject to availability, a loan computer will be issued to me if I am to be without a device for more than 48 hours. I will not be issued a loan computer until any necessary excess fees are paid.
- 5** If the computer is stolen or lost, I will inform the school as soon as possible.
- 6** The IT office will not assist me with connecting the computer to my home internet or printers.
- 7** The IT office opening hours are before school, first break (morning tea) and after school. The IT office is not able to offer me assistance during class time, spares or study periods.
- 8** I am required to bring the computer to every lesson, fully charged in a safe and working condition.
- 9** I will not apply stickers to the computer or personalise the computer with labels or graffiti. This is considered malicious damage and charges will apply.
- 10** Varsity College does not control internet filtering. This is managed by Education Queensland and we cannot disable or alter this functionality.
- 11** The device issued to me remains the property of Varsity College. Any damage to school property – including the computer – will be taken very seriously.
- 12** I will never share my password with anyone, including friends and other students.
- 13** I will never use another student or staff member's user account to access network resources, files or the internet.
- 14** It is my responsibility to take care of the computer and charger and pay for a replacement if they are lost or stolen.
- 15** Playing of computer games and/or online games is strictly forbidden during school hours.

parent conditions

In addition to the student conditions, I also understand that...

- 1** My child will be disciplined for using ICT facilities in an inappropriate manner, this includes playing games during class time. This may include suspension, permanent ban from the One2One program, or restricted network and internet access.
- 2** While we will endeavour to protect students from online threats, Varsity College is not responsible for students' access to information through their computer that is illegal, dangerous or offensive.
- 3** Repairs to the computer will not incur a fee unless it is determined by the IT department staff there is evidence of mistreatment, wilful/malicious treatment or carelessness. Excess charges start at **\$40** however, in serious cases, excess charges can exceed \$200. There is a limit of three accidental damage claims per year as determined by the manufacturer. There is no limit for warranty claims. Varsity College handles all repairs through their One2One Support Office.
- 4** If accidental damage claims have been exhausted for the year, I will be responsible for all costs to repair the computer, including parts and labour – this may exceed \$1,000.
- 5** If the computer is stolen, I must obtain a **police report** and pay a **\$200** excess fee to have it replaced with a computer from our reconditioned stock. This will not be a new device. Please notify the IT department as soon as possible in the event of a stolen device.
- 6** This contract comes into effect upon signing by both Student and Parent/Guardian and is valid until terminated at the discretion of Varsity College. This contract is subject to change at the discretion of Varsity College.
- 7** I must pay for the replacement of any lost or stolen items such as chargers or stylus pens (where applicable).
